Supply files in press quality PDF format with all fonts and 300dpi (min.) CMYK images embedded. **NO CROP MARKS.** All full bleed ads (bleeds are included in the above full bleed ad sizes) **must include a minimum margin of 0.375" around all ad edges.** Please **DO NOT** include text or graphics that you do not want cut off by the printer in this area. Note: the live sizes of full bleed ads that are the full bleed ad sizes minus 0.25" (i.e. the full page live ad size is 8.5" by 11").

Advertisers are encouraged to provide their logo, as well as any supporting imagery (such as high quality images of their staff, facility, products, etc.) to further enhance the feature's market appeal.

NOTE: Prior to writing the article, our team will discuss an overall theme with you and conduct any necessary research, such as interviewing one or two of your team members. You will also receive a draft of the article for review and approval before it is printed.

Business Features are charged at premium prices due to their impact and the additional costs for writing, editing and design. The fee is \$4,250 per issue.
